The Office of International Education will expand programming options for students to experience global learning by 10% The Office of International Education will report on expanded global learning experiences through new majors explored and innovative programming.

Global learning opportunities will increase annually.

During the 2021-2022 academic year, 134 USA students participated in physical mobility education abroad programs. Three of these students participated in multiple study abroad programs, bringing our total enrollment to 137 for the academic year. This represents a return to travel for USA students, as travel was suspended in March of 2020. Additionally, 126 USA students participated in international virtual engagement experiences, including USA courses.
